- People with low incomes displaced): m-banking solutions. accessible e-learning on-line solutions, job seekers platforms based on mobile technologies (e-lance, etc.)
- Population living in isolated areas (e.g. forests, high mountains, amazonas, etc.): m-banking solutions, accessible elearning on-line solutions, Tools for ensuring communication; Tools for cultural heritage preservation, etc.

M-Inclusion Events

Peru

UPCH, as the Peruvian leader, organized the M-Inclusion National event on July the 19th, 2013. The event took place at Hotel El Sol de Oro, in Miraflores district, in Lima, the capital. The event was addressed to the End Users and Academic community due to the profile of UPCH. Dr. Walter H. Curioso closed the event with some key points.

First, mobile technologies alone will not solve the problem of social exclusion, despite the fact that people can get free equipment for mobile technology.

Second, technology should offer a concrete benefit to the End Users in order to create an impact in public health.

Third, it is always important to validate the content and the technology, with focus groups and studies of social sciences, in order to identify the real needs and to be able to use the technology as a tool for improving the health of the people.

Fourth, Dr. Curioso mentioned several funding sources offered by the Government that can help the development of interventions with mobile technology such as projects FITEL and YACHAIWASI DIGITAL. Finally, Dr. Curioso emphasized the need for creating links between academics, public health professionals and technology developers in order to identify gaps and solutions for social inclusion.

Universidad Cayetano Heredia as M-Inlusion Partner assesses positively the impact of the Peruvian event. The number of attendees was about the initially expected participants (40) and the discussions during the event were very positive and illustrative of the potential of mobile technologies for the creation of social inclusion.

Colombia

The National Dissemination Event of M-Inclusion in Colombia , organized by Futura Networks, was held on October 12 (2013) at 10:00 am (UTC -5), in the context of Campus Party Colombia 2013.

The event's agenda included a roundtable and an showroom in the Open Zone of Campus Party.

The showroom consisted on an exhibition to test and evaluate some social applications aimed to the four target groups of M-Inclusion. It was operative on Friday 11 and on Saturday 12 during the whole day.

The conference "Social Apps, join the opportunity" counted on about attendees. The panel was moderated by Esther Paniagua, coordinator of Campus Labs and leader of M-Inclusion by the side of Futura Networks. She was accompanied by developers and social entrepreneurs as Asier Arranz -creator, among others, of Malaria Spot, an online game that helps to diagnose malaria-, Ignacio Vidal -founder of the social platform Socialab in Colombia- or Juan Sebastian Osorio -a biomedical engineer and project manager of the Colombian division of MIT Sana Mobile Health (a program of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology).

This roundtable included a practical activity that involved to the participants. They were asked to write simple proposals to solve
